

Directions

From Alford travel north on the A944 (Old Military Road) for approximately 1 mile, after crossing the River Don turn right. Continue on this road for half a mile, passing through the small village of Bridge of Alford. Leaving Bridge of Alford there will be a signpost to 'Clatt, Kennethmont and Tullynessle', turn left onto Suie Road and the plot can be found on the right hand side of the road, opposite 'Tullynessle & Forbes Hall'. The exact location is shown on the attached Ordnance Survey extract.

Description

Situated in the Howe of Alford, this generous sized plot provides a fantastic opportunity, found at the edge of the quaint village of Bridge of Alford with stunning views of the surrounding area. The south facing site has planning permission in principle for the erection of a dwelling house and garage. Further information can be found on the Aberdeenshire Council planning portal website using the reference code APP/2018/1369 or within Aberdeen & Northern Estates office.

The nearby popular town of Alford provides a range of local amenities including primary and secondary education at the modern Alford Community Campus which includes swimming pool, sports hall, library & theatre. Alford also has a supermarket, an 18 hole golf course and is home to the Alford Ski Centre. Other recreational opportunities including the Grampian Transport Museum and Haughton and Murray Country Park.

The Cairngorms National Park can be found to the west and showcases some of the best recreational opportunities and scenery Scotland has to offer.

Aberdeen is only 28 miles east, and provides a wealth of shopping facilities, theatre, two universities, mainline railway station and international airport.
